2.	Let's open the meeting with a moment of silence, followed by the Serenity Prayer. <i>Recite Serenity Prayer.</i>
3.	<i>The Preamble (ask for a volunteer to read the handout)</i>
4.	a) Are there newcomers to the meeting that would like to introduce themselves? b) Let's go around the room and introduce ourselves by first name only. c) For those on Zoom, please introduce yourself by first name only.
5.	The <i>Step & Tradition</i> of the month <i>(ask for a volunteer to read the handout)</i>
6.	We ask that people limit their shares to allow for as many shares as possible. A timekeeper will hold up a sign to signal when you are reaching the time limit. <i>(Ask for a volunteer to be the timekeeper)</i>
7.	Can I have a volunteer to read and then share on today's <i>Daily Reflection</i> Afterward, you may choose where to begin the sharing around the room.
